



WEEK 2 - The Star

Craft: Star Suncatcher

Supplies:

10 Popsiclesticks, Hot glue, & Tissue paper pieces.

Instructions:

Step 1- To make sure your angles are ideal to create a star shape, lay out your craft sticks before gluing them, then glue together two craft sticks in a triangle, as shown.

Step 2- Glue another triangle with two craft sticks, and glue it to the first triangle, as shown.

Step 3- Repeat Steps 1 & 2 until you've created a 5-point star.

Step 4- Your completed star will look like this!

Step 5- Peel back the paper backing of your contact paper and lay the star down on it. Push down firmly.

Step 6- An adult can carefully cut the sides of the contact paper off, leaving just the wooden star with contact paper on it.

Step 7- Take the tissue paper pieces and press down on the sticky side of contact paper. Cover all the contact paper.

Completed Star! Now you can make additional ones using supplies at home or the cardstock PDF downloadable on our YouTube video for week 2.

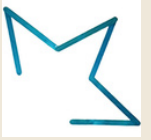

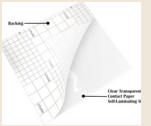
